Dear Parents and Staff,

We rely on parents and staff to be vigilant in monitoring health. These links will help you in your vigilance.

Our community has been vigilant in reporting and keeping their children home or staying home if sick.

**Students or staff should not attend school until they no longer have symptoms for 24 hours.**

In order to keep information **confidential** and in order to provide parents and staff with clear and timely information in the event of an outbreak it is important to do the following:

Report Covid-like [symptoms](#) to the principal in an email with “Symptoms” in the subject line.

Call the Covid line (514-644-4545). If you are calling concerning someone in your household with symptoms, ask if the adults without symptoms should also be self-isolating. Report this information and any other relevant information in your email to the principal.

Report official Covid diagnosis (positive or negative) to the principal in an email with “Diagnosis” in the subject line. Report the details, if any, of the diagnosis in the email.

**Do not** include information about Covid-like symptoms or covid testing when reporting an absence to the absence line or to the teacher. Simply report the absence saying “I have communicated with the principal”. All non-covid related reasons should be reported to the teacher and/or absence line.

If the principal, in consultation with Public Health, deem it necessary to cancel school for a group or groups of students, or the entire school, it will be communicated via ERMS (Emergency Response Messaging Service). This can be an email or an automated phone call to up to 4 phone numbers on file simultaneous.
